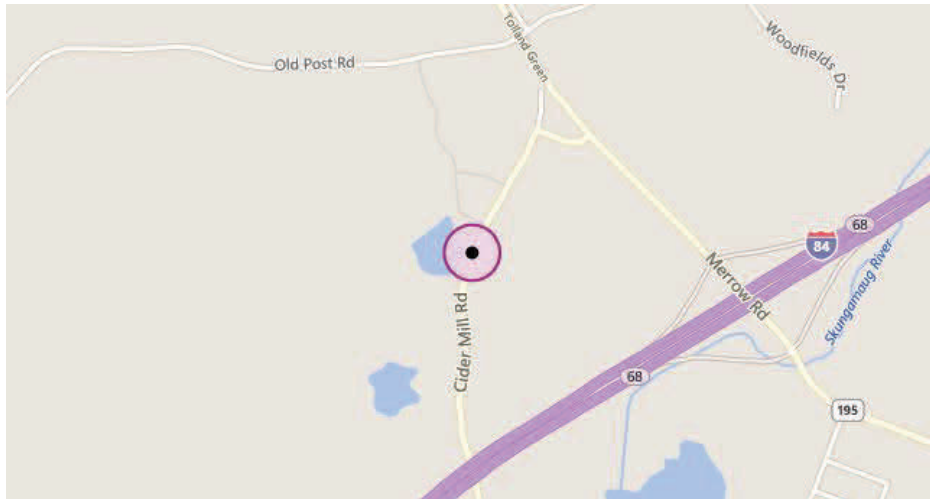
Directions

Coming from the East

- Take exit 68 off of I-84 east.
- At the end of the exit take a left.
- Turn left onto Cider Mill Extension.
- At the stop sign, turn left onto Cider Mill Road.
- Travel approximately a half a mile, Crandall's Park will be on your right hand side.

Coming from the West

- Take exit 68 off of I-84 west.
- At the end of the exit take a right.
- Turn left onto Cider Mill Extension.
- At the stop sign, turn left onto Cider Mill Road.
- Travel approximately a half a mile, Crandall's Park will be on your right hand side

Between the months of April-September

Tolland Resident(s)/Tolland Non-Profit Group(s) -
\$20.00 – 4 hours minimum

NonResident(s)/Business Group(s) -
\$40.00 – 4 hours minimum

Extra Charges: Beer / Wine - \$25.00 per hour

BEACH FEES (when open for Operation)

Beach access is NOT included in rental of Pavilion

RULES

- The Pavilion must be rented in advance at the Recreation Office during regular office hours.
- Rental fee(s) are due at time of reservation.
- Rental groups have exclusive use of the Pavilion, sand volleyball court, big charcoal grill and horseshoe pits. Horseshoes provided upon.
- Renter is responsible for any damage or loss of equipment resulting from their use.
- Ball field is available to renter if it is not previously reserved.
- **NO HARD ALCOHOL / BEER / WINE ALLOWED at the Pavilion events when beach is open Mid June through Mid August.**
- Glass bottles of any kind are not allowed. Recyclable products such as card board, plastic, aluminum cans, etc. must be removed by the renter after the event.
